

DEVOTION: JOHN 15:1-8

1 "I am the real vine, and my Father is the gardener. **2** He breaks off every branch in me that does not bear fruit, and he prunes every branch that does bear fruit, so that it will be clean and bear more fruit. **3** You have been made clean already by the teaching I have given you. **4** Remain united to me, and I will remain united to you. A branch cannot bear fruit by itself; it can do so only if it remains in the vine. In the same way you cannot bear fruit unless you remain in



me. **5** "I am the vine, and you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will bear much fruit; for you can do nothing without me. **6** Those who do not remain in me are thrown out like a branch and dry up; such branches are gathered up and thrown into the fire, where they are burned. **7** If you remain in me and my words remain in you, then you will ask for anything you wish, and you shall have it. **8** My Father's glory is shown by your bearing much fruit; and in this way you become my disciples.

ST CHAD'S AT PRAYER: Monday 29 April 2024

Let us pray: (*Psalm 8*) O LORD, our Lord, how excellent is Your name in all the earth. Who have set Your glory above the heavens! Out of the mouths of babes and infants You have ordained strength, because of Your enemies, that You may silence the enemy and the avenger. When we



consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, the moon and the stars, which You have ordained, what is man that You are mindful of him, and the son of man that You visit him? Glorious God, thank you for making us a little lower than the angels, and crowning us with glory and honour. Thank you for giving us dominion over the works of Your hands; You have put all things under our feet, all sheep and oxen - even the beasts of the field, the birds of the air, and the fish of the sea that pass through the paths of the seas. O LORD, our Lord, how excellent is Your name in all the earth! Glory and honour be to You our God. Amen.

Tuesday 30 April 2024

Let us pray: "As far as the east is from the west, so far has he moved our transgressions from us' (Psalm 103:12). Loving Lord, You tell us in Your Word that whatever wrong we have done You tread down our faults to the bottom of the sea. Father, we know there is no need to keep thinking about what we have done in the past, if we have brought it to You in repentance, seeking forgiveness, for You pardon the wrongs we have done, and You delight in showing mercy. You bind up all our wounds and You renew us by Your love. Lord, You love all that You have made, and it is Your very nature to love and forgive. Lead us to be generous in accepting and forgiving others, in the same way as You accept and forgive us. Amen.

Wednesday 1 May 2024

Let us pray: Lord Jesus, it is a command from our heavenly Father that we should pray for our spiritual leaders, and so we pray for all ministers of Your Word and Sacrament, especially Fr. Tobias, our Rector and Archdeacon and Fr. Michael, our assistant priest. Lord, give to each of them wisdom, help them to seek order and discipline in prayer, and inspire them in their preaching and teaching. We pray for all the parishes of our Diocese. Bless the clergy, wardens and people of every parish and chapelry. We bring before You, dear Lord, all diocesan meetings, Bishop Raphael, facilitators and all who are involved. Thursday 2 May 2024

Let us pray: Judge of the whole earth, we come to plead for mercy and grace for our community and our land. Justice is far from us. We stumble and fall because our transgressions are with us, and we know our iniquities. We have transgressed and lied against You and departed from our God. We speak oppression and revolt, conceiving and uttering from the heart words of falsehood. Often justice is turned back in our nations and righteousness stands far off; truth is fallen in the street. (Isa.59:9-15) The land mourns and is defiled under its inhabitants, because they have transgressed the laws and broken covenant with You. Therefore, a curse consumes our land. (Isa.24:3-6) We are building our own houses through unrighteousness, using services without paying wages. (Jer.22:13) Many of our cities are established by iniquity. (Hab.2:12) We have unjust laws and oppressive decrees, depriving the poor of justice and withholding justice from the oppressed, making widows a prev and robbing the fatherless. (Isa. 10:2) We repent, we ask forgiveness, we turn back to You. Fill our hearts with truth and righteousness and heal our land. We ask this in Jesus' Name. Amen.

Friday 3 May 2024

Let us pray: Gracious Lord, we lift up our families; our homes; homes which are single-parent and youth-led. Today we pray specifically for our children, our own children and other children we know personally. We also pray for neighbours' children, children in our local schools, friends of our children, the children of acquaintances and street children. Lord. You made them and formed them in their mother's womb and want to engrave their names in the palms of Your hands (Isa.49:16). Lord Jesus, we pray that God's Spirit of power, love and self-discipline, will fill each and every one of our children. We pray for a hunger and a thirst in the hearts of our young people, that they start praying together, and have a greater desire to read and pray from the Word. Lord, we plead for their physical safety and care, so also Lord, do we pray for the safety and care of street children and all who are homeless, for they, whatever their age, are Your children. Merciful God, we lift to You the lives of all who are lost. Rescue them and be their refuge. Amen.

God be in my eyes and in my looking.
