## COLLECT: FOR EASTER DAY

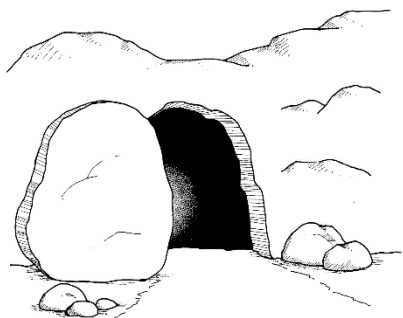
Lord Jesus Christ

## DEVOTION: MARK 16:1-8

16 When the Sabbath was over, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices so that they might go to anoint Jesus' body. 2 Very early on the first day of the week, just after sunrise, they were on their way to the tomb 3 and they asked each other, "Who will roll the stone away from the entrance of the tomb?" 4 But when they looked up, they saw that the stone, which was very large, had been rolled away. 5 As they entered the tomb, they saw a young man dressed in a white robe sitting on the right side, and they were alarmed. 6 "Don't be alarmed," he said. "You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid him. 7 But go, tell his disciples and Peter, 'He is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you.'" 8 Trembling and bewildered, the women went out and fled from the tomb. They said nothing to anyone, because they were afraid.

Monday 1 April 2024

**Let us pray:** Lord Jesus, we sign our hearts with the sign of the cross; remind us daily of Your love for us and for each person. We sign our lips with the sign of the cross; may we speak as You would speak. We sign our hands with the sign of the cross; enable us to do Your work and be Your hands in our church, community, and the world. We sign our eyes with the sign of Your cross; may we really see Lord and be aware of all that is around us. We sign our ears with the sign of the cross; may we listen and really hear the communication that comes to us in different ways - from You and from the people in our lives. We sign our shoulders with the sign of the cross; help us to carry our own cross each day and support others in the burdens and difficulties that they have. Father, all that we do this day, we set out to do in the name of the Father and of the Son and of Holy Spirit. Amen.

Tuesday 2 April 2024

**Let us pray:** Father, cause us again to forsake worldliness and the flesh. Lord, create in us a pure heart, so that Your name may be lifted up in all we do and say. Forgive us our arrogance, abrasiveness, aggressiveness and our proneness to moods, our lack of mercy and our hunger for power. Father, You died so that we may not be a slave to the flesh and the world, and promised Holy Spirit to us, as a gift to overcome the works of the flesh - give us Holy Spirit today. Fill us with Holy Spirit and give us victory over sin and enable us to live a life totally surrendered to You; willing to sacrifice and to suffer because we follow Christ. Amen.

Wednesday 3 April 2024

**Let us pray:** Father, may the death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ, bring us a fresh and new understanding of the depth of Your love. This Easter, may we and especially those who do not know Christ, experience Your trustworthiness in a very personal way. We pray that we will come to a deep understanding, that it is only the Blood of Jesus which cleanses us from sin. We pray for those who have come to salvation through Christ that they might grow spiritually and not backslide. We pray for the salvation of souls - for those who have not yet made this decision for Christ, that they be convicted and open to the message of the sacrifice Jesus made for their sins and that they surrender their lives to Jesus. Amen.

Thursday 4 April 2024

**Let us pray:** *For he stands at the right hand of the needy, to save them from those who would condemn them to death. (Psalm 109:31).* Abba Father, it is Your will that we, as Your Church, take care of the poor and the destitute. Forgive us our apathy for the plight of the poor and the lost. Forgive us when we judge or make assumptions. Only You Lord God, know everything. Father help us through the working of Holy Spirit, to become more actively involved in the needs of people. Help us to step out in faith and do what You require of us; help us to share with those who have so much less than we do. Help us to do more. We pray for all who are in need. Father, when we encounter the needy, beggars, those who do not know You, may we be faithful in sharing the gospel with them, not just in word, but also in deed, and encourage them to do what is right. Lord, we pray a blessing on the poor and the lost. Pour out Your grace upon them, the same grace You show us. We ask, for Your love's sake. Amen.

Friday 5 April 2024

**Let us pray:** We come to You Lord Jesus as the Mediator of the new covenant. Thank You for demonstrating Your love towards us, that while we were still sinners, You, Our Christ, died for us. We thank you dear Lord for the Body of Jesus, sacrificed on Mount Calvary. Heavenly Father, we pray for the hearts and minds of all people in South Africa, Africa and the World, who deny Christ. We pray that their spirits be touched and their hearts filled with love. Lord God, give them a fresh realization of the awesome gift of life which they have received. We pray that many would come to the understanding of Your Grace; that their eyes may be opened, that they would turn from darkness to light. Amen.
